Be ready for your COVID-19 vaccine



Getting the COVID-19 vaccination is a safe and effective way to protect yourself and the community. Vaccines have been saving lives for decades. By doing your part and receiving the vaccine, you can help our world get back to normal. Here are some important things to do to get ready to receive your vaccine!

Preparing for your vaccine

- ☐ Talk to your doctor about the medication that you take and allergies you may have.
- ☐ Make an appointment for your first round of the vaccine here: <https://myvaccine.fl.gov/>
- ☐ Plan to find COVID safe, socially distanced, and accessible transportation options to the nearest vaccination location.
- ☐ Prepare for vaccine side effects; common side effects are pain in the arm and a small fever. Talk to your doctor if side effects worry you and don't go away after a few days.
- ☐ Set up your appointment to get the second round of the vaccine. Both types of the COVID-19 vaccine require a second shot to fully protect you.
- ☐ Continue COVID-19 safety precautions before, during, and after receiving your vaccine. This includes maintaining a social distance of 6 or more feet, wearing a face mask, and regular hand washing.
